



We are a radio-controlled (RC) aircraft club in Southern Arizona. Our club was formed in January, 1984 by seven men in response to an ad placed in the Green Valley News. At the present time, there are more than 70 members.

Our purpose is to further the sport of radio controlled model aviation. Our members fly electric, nitro, and gas-powered planes and aero-towed gliders. We don't have multi rotor or helicopter facilities. We provide and maintain two flying sites in the Green Valley area:

FICO is a flying field within the Pecan Groves that we use with permission from the owners.

Twin Buttes is a field that we lease from Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold Inc.

Members fly nearly every morning at the FICO field, weather permitting. The busiest days of the week are Wednesday and Saturday.

Club meetings are held at 7:00 PM on the second Monday of each month in the Recreation Center of the La Posada retirement community in Green Valley. Visitors are always welcome at the meetings.

Membership is required in the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA), the governing body that issues club regulations and liability insurance. AMA yearly dues are \$75 (19-65) or \$65 (65 or older). This includes the monthly magazine, "Model Aviation". The AMA web site is: www.modelaircraft.org
